RE: PINSTAMP Marking

The cross section of an impression (dot) imprinted by a PINSTAMP marker has no sharp corners, only very gentle curves. Therefore, these dots induce no stress concentrations in the parent material being marked. For that reason in almost any application the structural integrity of the part being marked is not compromised. This allows PINSTAMP markers to be used to mark many critical parts including many aircraft parts, by manufactures such as G. E. Aerospace, Pratt and Whitney and Boeing.
